**SUBJECT:** US&R General Memorandum 2015-077 – Emergency Management Assessment

Program US&R Standard Additional Public Comment Period

This General Memorandum (GM) notifies the National Urban Search and Rescue (US&R) Response System (the System) of a second public comment period for the Emergency Management Assessment Program (EMAP) US&R Assessment Standard.

GM 2015-024 – *Public Comment Period for 2015 Emergency Management Assessment Program* announced the initial public comment period for the EMAP US&R Standard. Based upon the adjudication of all comments received from that process, substantial changes were made to the Standard and an additional 45-day public comment period for the revised version begins today. The System strongly encourages all Sponsoring Agencies / task forces to carefully review this revised standard and provide comment as required. The US&R Branch intends to provide consolidated comment on behalf of all 28 task forces in the System.

The public comment period deadline is September 25<sup>th</sup> and the Standard can be accessed by going to the EMAP website at <a href="www.emap.org">www.emap.org</a>.

In order to provide a unified response, individual task forces are asked to provide any comments to their Task Force Representative – Divisional (TFR-D) listed below:
