Massachusetts Task Force One (MA-TF1) is hosting a National Urban Search & Rescue (US&R) Response System (the System) Canine Search Team Certification Evaluation – Live Find (CSTCE-LF) in Littleton, Massachusetts on June 4 and 5, 2016. There will be no registration fee for this evaluation, but task forces will be responsible for their members' travel, lodging and per diem expenses. The CSTCE-LF is open to System candidates who have passed a Foundation Skills Assessment and are seeking to certify, or re-certify, as System CSTs.

Space is limited to 28 candidates and applications must be submitted to Scott Mateyaschuk and Janet Merrill at: <u>scott.mateyaschuk@nypd.org</u> and <u>wahospjm@tellink.net</u> by May 6, 2016. The attached logistics letter includes event specific information and the application. For additional information, contact the individual identified on the logistics letter.

This CSTCE is within scope of the FY2015 Readiness Cooperative Agreement. Funding for registration, travel and related costs to send System members are allowable expenses, provided the individual's task force has budgeted for this expense. Task Force Representatives are asked to coordinate this information as appropriate with their Task Force Training Managers.

The event will be held at Aggregate Industries, 149 Ayer Road, Littleton, MA 01460 on June 4 & 5, 2016. The following logistical information is provided to assist in the planning for candidates to attend. There is no application fee to participate in this evaluation. Task Forces who send participants will be responsible for supporting their member's travel, lodging and per diem expenses.

The Certification Evaluation is open to candidates who have passed a Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) and are seeking to certify or re-certify as FEMA Canine Search Specialist Team. The application for this evaluation is attached.

Space is limited to 28 applicants. The due date for applications is *May 6, 2016* Accepted applications will be confirmed by e-mail on *May 10, 2016*. If space is available, applications *may* be accepted after the due day to fill any open spots.

A mandatory Orientation/Safety Briefing will take place the night before the candidates test date at 7:00 pm at the Westford Regency Inn & Conference Center. Applicants will also be expected to attend the evaluation debriefing at the conclusion of their test date.

Ground Transportation: Candidates are responsible for transportation to/from the airport, hotel and evaluation site. A rental car is recommended.

Airport: Boston Logan International Airport (BOS) or Manchester Airport (MHT)

Lodging: Westford Regency Inn & Conference Center, 219 Littleton Road, Westford, MA 01886. (978) 692-8200. Accommodations are available at the federal per diem rate of \$136.00/night plus tax. Reservations will be available beginning April 20th under the "FEMA K9" block and candidates must secure their reservations no later than *May 13, 2016* in order to receive the federal per diem rate.

Candidates are expected to provide their own personal protective equipment appropriate for rubble pile entry. **Teams without proper personal protective equipment will not be allowed to participate in the evaluation**. Portable kennels are also the responsibility of the candidate.
