On behalf of the National Urban Search & Rescue (US&R) Response System (the System), California Task Force Seven (CA-TF7) is hosting the Heavy Equipment and Rigging Specialist (HERS) Course, October 3-6, 2016.

This blended learning HERS Course is 38.0 hours in length; 6.0 hours of Computer Based Training (CBT), and 32.0 hours of Instructor Led Training (ILT). The ILT will be conducted at the Operating Engineers Local Three Training Facility 14738 Cantova Way, Sloughhouse CA 95683.

Registration is limited to 28 students. Task force management MUST register students via the LMS. Student selection is solely the decision of task force management and new or existing students or instructors are welcome. Students registered for this course are required to complete the CBT portion, and bring their CBT Certificate of Completion on the first day of class. Upon confirmation of acceptance, registration for the ILT portion of the class is also required. Since this class is expected to be full, a wait list will be established within the LMS.

FEMA Urban Search & Rescue Heavy Equipment & Rigging Specialist

- DESCRIPTION:** This is a FEMA Sponsored Heavy Equipment and Rigging Training Course. This course is being hosted by CA-TF7 (Sacramento). This course meets all FEMA requirements for HERS. Students will be trained in ordering and helping to set up cranes, communicating with crane operators, making lifts that are unique to US&R, and normal crane and rigging operations.
- PREREQUISITE:** Students must be members of a FEMA US&R Task Force and been through a minimum of a team orientation. This class is designed for all students who meet the FEMA Task Force Position Description General Training Requirements. Students will be provided a list of equipment to bring to class in an enrollment confirmation letter.
- DATES & TIMES:** **October 3-6, 2016.** Mon-Thurs, 0800-1700; Travel Days: October 2 (Sunday) and October 7 (Friday) ** For those who prefer to travel home on the final day of class (Thursday), plan on travel/air travel after 1900.

**All students must complete 6 hours of CBT (Computer Bases Training) through the www.esf9training.org Learning Management System prior to the first day of class. Task Force Training Managers are responsible for enrolling their students in the CBT if the Task Force has not enabled the self enroll feature.

- ENROLLMENT:** Deadline to register is Friday, September 23, 2016. Enrollment is limited to 1 student per US&R Task Force. A fee of \$240.00 is required for breakfast & lunches provided Mon-Thurs. Complete the attached Registration Form and email to nicole.paskey@fireandrescuetraining.ca.gov. All students can be registered for the Instructor-Led Training (ILT) Course within the www.esf9training.org Learning Management System. All enrolled students will receive a confirmation letter with more detailed information including required equipment.
- TRAVEL & LODGING:** Agencies are responsible for each student's travel & lodging. Closest Airport is Sacramento International Airport (SMF). It is recommended that air travelers rent a vehicle; training is at a remote location. Breakfast & Lunch will be provided Monday-Thursday at the training site. Agencies are responsible for remaining per diem.

Travel time to and from Airport and Training Site is approximately 20 minutes from the Hotel. A group rate of \$129.00 per night (plus tax) is available at Hyatt Place Sacramento Rancho Cordova under the name "FEMA HERS." Reservations can be made by contacting the Hyatt Place Sacramento Rancho Cordova directly at (916) 635-4799. This room rate is valid until **September 2, 2016.**
- CLASS ATTIRE:** Task Force Uniform is required dress (BDU's). A specific list of PPE and equipment will be issued with the class confirmation letter.
- CERTIFICATION:** A Certificate of Completion will be provided by CFRTA as well as a FEMA Certificate.
