SUBJECT: Logistics Specialist Course

California Task Force 7 is pleased to announce we are hosting a Logistics Specialist Class in Sacramento, CA on May 2-5, 2017. The following logistical information is supplied to assist in your planning to send candidates from your Task Force. **All students will need to register for this course via the FEMA LMS website.** Task Forces who send participants will be responsible for supporting their member's travel, lodging and per diem expenses. Space is limited to 60 students and is determined on a first come basis.

Course Requirements: Each student must successfully complete the online content of the course via the FEMA US&R Learning Management System prior to attending this 4 day instructor led practical exercise portion of the course.

Required PPE: Your Task Force issued safety helmet, steel toed boots, goggles/safety glasses, gloves, hearing protection, knee/elbow protection, and Task Force approved work uniform.

Computer Requirements/Books:

- One computer per student and one (1) portable printer and power strip per TF.
- Task Force Deployment Transportation Inventory – filled out US&R18-4
- Transportation Load Plans for Air/Ground configuration
- TF Base of Operations Plan for Type I and Type III deployments
- TF Mobilization Plan
- Task Force Equipment Cache Inventory Database on the laptop (**no hard copies**).
- FEMA Field Operations Guide
- Small digital Camera (optional)

Class Times: Class begins May 2, 2016 at 0800 and ends on May 5, 2016 at 1700. Students should plan for 8 hour days with working lunches. Lunch will be provided by TF-7. Travel from the host hotel to the training site will be provided by CA TF-7. Pick up time will be 0700, every morning, in front of the host hotel. Students will be returned to the host hotel upon completion of the day.

Travel: Travel days should be May 1 and May 6 unless others arrangements have been made with the Training staff.

Airport: All air travel to Sacramento should be through Sacramento International Airport (SMF). Students are responsible for travel to and from the airport to the host hotel.
